

DECLARATION OF ESTABLISHMENT

of the Civic Movement “Building Trust”

The Republic of Moldova is currently facing a profound crisis of trust.

Without trust between citizens and institutions, no reform can truly succeed.

We, citizens of the Republic of Moldova—professionals from various fields, members of civil society, and members of communities both within the country and in the diaspora—united by the conviction that trust is the foundation of a functional and democratic society, hereby declare the establishment of the Civic Movement “Building Trust.”

We start from a reality we all feel: the ever-widening gap between citizens and public institutions, fueled by decisions made without real consultation, a lack of transparency, and promises that do not materialize in everyday life. Under these conditions, trust declines, and society becomes increasingly fragmented.

We are convinced that without trust there can be no social cohesion, and without cohesion there can be no sustainable development.

The Republic of Moldova is at a decisive moment in its European journey. European integration cannot remain merely a political or institutional objective. It must mean concrete results for people: fair institutions, quality public services, and respect for citizens. To achieve this, we need genuine participation, accountability, and authentic dialogue.

In this context, we are launching an open civic platform that aims to rebuild trust between citizens and institutions and to strengthen an active, informed, and engaged society.

Our mission is to bring citizens closer to the decision-making process, to encourage genuine participation, and to turn dialogue into concrete solutions. We aim to contribute to public policies that are more transparent, more accountable, and grounded in people’s real needs.

Our vision is a society where trust is not a slogan, but a reality: engaged and respected citizens, transparent and accountable institutions, and a European path based on results, not just declarations.

To achieve these goals, we commit to:

organizing genuine and accessible public consultations for citizens;

facilitate constant dialogue between society, the business community, and authorities;

monitor public decisions and accurately inform citizens;

develop and promote recommendations to increase transparency and accountability;

support civic initiatives at the local, regional, and national levels.

We are guided by clear values, demonstrated through action:

trust and accountability – every decision must be explained and owned;

transparency – not as an option, but as an obligation;

participation – citizens must be a real part of decision-making;

dialogue – based on respect and reasoned arguments, not on formalities;

inclusion – every voice matters.

The “Construim înCREDeRe” movement is a civic, independent, and nonpartisan initiative. We do not aim to replace state institutions, but to hold them accountable and help bring them closer to citizens.

We believe in the power of engagement and in each of our responsibilities to contribute to the common good.

Change does not happen on its own. It starts with each of us.

If we want a country we can trust, we must build it together—now.

We invite everyone who shares these values to join this effort and contribute, through ideas, expertise, and engagement, to building a society based on trust.
