🏠 Civic Movement “Building Trust” calls on the Government to reduce natural gas tariffs for household consumers!

As citizens of the Republic of Moldova face an imminent increase in natural gas prices to the crushing level of MDL 20.93/m³, other countries show that a responsible government acts decisively to protect its people in times of crisis.

The new British Prime Minister, Andy Burnham, who took office this week, announced as his first government measure the complete removal of VAT on electricity for household consumers starting on 1 October.

Previously, the Spanish authorities decided to temporarily reduce VAT on natural gas, electricity and fuels from 21% to 10%.

In Italy, a major tax relief package worth EUR 608 million was approved to reduce prices at the pump and energy bills through temporary cuts in taxes and excise duties.

In this critical context, Civic Movement “Building Trust” calls on the Government to apply a principle of fairness: abolish the 8% VAT rate on natural gas supplied to household consumers.

In times of deep crisis, the state must be a shield for its citizens, not a collector of higher taxes through their utility bills.
